New Student Orientation is required of all students who will take classes at SSU for the first time. It is an excellent opportunity to get acquainted with the campus, university policies, procedures, resources and services. Academic advisors will be available to discuss degree requirements and help you plan your first semester schedule.

Parental involvement is a crucial ingredient to your college success. For that reason, we welcome and encourage your parents or guardians to attend at least the first two days of orientation, where they will find

informational sessions geared specifically to answer their questions and concerns. We want to make sure your parents are equipped with the knowledge to help you be successful.

There will be advice on parenting a college student, the ins and outs of residential living, financial aid, and how to keep the communication lines open via e-mail and more. Parents will have the opportunity to pose questions to the president and other administrators, faculty members, orientation leaders and others. Orientation 2005 is packed with learning and fun.

ORIENTATION LEADERS

The New Student Orientation Leaders are eager to make Orientation 2005 an unforgettable experience. They will serve as your guide and mentors during the orientation sessions and will be available to assist you throughout the academic year.

MARKET PLACE

At the Market Place, we will have representatives from campus clubs & organizations, area banks, insurance companies and outside health services on hand to acquaint you with their services.

HOUSING AND HOTEL

Students who have signed and returned their housing reservation agreements will have access to campus housing when they arrive for orientation. Parents, guardians and other guests will need to make reservations with one of the many fine hotels, inns or motels in Savannah; a partial listing is on the opposite side of this form. TESTING

All new students must take a diagnostic writing assessment prior to advisement and registration for classes. Some students may also need to take the placement exams in reading, English and mathematics.

Also, students pursuing degrees in the College of Sciences and Technology may have to take an additional test. Unless otherwise noted, all test sessions begin at 8:00 a.m. in Whiting Hall, Room 112. Please bring with you two #2 pencils, a ballpoint pen with blue or black ink, and a valid photo ID for admission. SERVICE OF DEDICATION

One of Savannah State University's longstanding traditions is the New Student Service of Dedication. During this sacred program, all new SSU students are officially inducted into the Tiger Family. Women are asked to wear white dresses, and



men are asked to wear dark suits or white shirts and dark pants and ties for this ceremony.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is available to students who demonstrate the need for funds. The first step in the process is to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You should check with the Office of Financial Aid to make sure that all required documents have been submitted so that the staff may evaluate your request. ORIENTATION REGISTRATION

The orientation fee for each participant is \$70 per student, which will cover all program materials, activities, a t-shirt, and social events. Parents and guardians may register at no cost. Due to limited space, we ask that students bring no more than three guests. Complete the enclosed reservation form and return it with the appropriate fees by July 31, 2005.

CANCELLATION

If it becomes necessary to cancel, 80% of the registration fee will be returned if your written notification is postmarked by August 5, 2005. Include the student's name and social security number in all correspondence and mail to Savannah State University, P.O. Box 20316, Savannah, Georgia 31404. Refunds will be processed approximately eight weeks after the end of orientation. Letters postmarked after August 5, 2005, and no shows will not be eligible for refunds.

Directions to SSU Campus

FROM 1-16: EAST

Take exit 164A/ Lynes Parkway South, which becomes DeRenne Avenue at the first traffic light.

- Continue East (straight ahead) on DeRenne Avenue to LaRoche Avenue. You will go through 11 traffic lights until DeRenne ends. Landmarks include Checkers, Candler Hospital, Walgreen's, Jenkins High School, and Coastal Christian Church.
- 2. Turn left onto LaRoche Avenue, Keep straight. Landmarks include a BP/Amoco convenience store and Bible Baptist Church.
- 3. Turn right onto campus at first light.
- 3. At stop sign make a right and follow orientation signs.
